Pre-1800	<b>Sour Family</b> £12	Appeared in the middle of the eighteenth century in England <i>Your choice of spirit, sugar, lemon juice, egg white</i>
1800-1840	<b>Flip Family</b> £12	Flip recipes from Colonial times were hot drinks, with as many variations as there were inns on the Boston Post Road. This recipe calls for the drink to be served chilled <i>Your choice of spirit, sherry or port, sugar, egg white and yolk</i>
1840-1850	<b>Pimm's Cup No.1</b> £12	Possibly the first English cocktail whose early definition was a 'bittered sling'; invented by James Pimm for his oyster bar in London around the 1840s <i>Pimm's No.1, Lemonade, soda, fresh fruit</i>
	<b>Pink Gin</b> £12	Drunk since 1848 by officers of the Royal Navy <i>Gin, Angostura or Orange Bitter's</i>
1850-1870	<b>Champagne Cobbler</b> £15	Cobbler's appeared in prominent books of the period; How to Mix Drinks or The Bon-Vivant's Companion <i>Maraschino liqueur, Champagne, fresh orange &amp; pineapple</i>
	<b>Fix Family</b> £12	This family of short drinks was most popular for its Brandy & Gin variations in the United States at the end of the 1850s. <i>Your choice of spirit, sugar, lemon juice, egg white, seasonal fresh fruit</i>

1964	<b>Château De Gaube à Perquie</b> £35.00	A young and fresh nose for this age. With subtle hints of apples, walnuts, and almonds <i>The perfectly balanced, a sign of a perfectly controlled aging, an impressive finish</i>

	<b>Champagne Julep</b> £15	Invented in New York; attributed to William Schmidt; juleps were the first American drinks to attract international attention <i>Champagne, fresh mint, sugar</i>
1900-1910	<b>Old-Fashioned</b> £12	Invented between 1900 and 1907 at the Pendennis Club in Louisville, Kentucky; the granddaddy of which is the 1862 Whiskey Cobbler <i>Bourbon, Angostura, orange, sugar, soda</i>
	<b>Clover Club</b> £12	Invented between 1900 and 1908 credited to the Bellevue-Stratford Hotel in Philadelphia by Albert Stevens Crockett for the members of the Clover Club <i>Gin, sugar, lemon juice, raspberry syrup, egg white</i>

	<b>Mimosa</b> £15	Invented in 1925 in Paris and attributed to Frank Meier of The Ritz Hotel bar <i>Champagne, fresh orange juice</i>
	<b>Negroni</b> £12	Created in Florence around 1920s at Casoni Bar, when Count Camillo Negroni asked for gin to be added to his Americano <i>Campari, Gin, Sweet Vermouth</i>
	<b>Hemingway Daiquiri (Papa Doble)</b> £12	The cocktail muse inspired Constantino Ribalaigua of the Floridita Bar in Havana to create this, the result is ambrosia <i>White Rum, Maraschino liqueur, grapefruit juice, sugar, fresh lime juice</i>
	<b>Mojito</b> £12	La Bodeguita del Medio in Havana is credited for popularizing this cocktail, although some believe that Constantino Ribalaigua of The Floridita made the first mojito <i>Cuban Rum, fresh mint, sugar, Angostura, soda</i>
